Please join the National Park Service and the United States Military Academy as we commemorate the 195th Anniversary of the birth of Ulysses S. Grant.

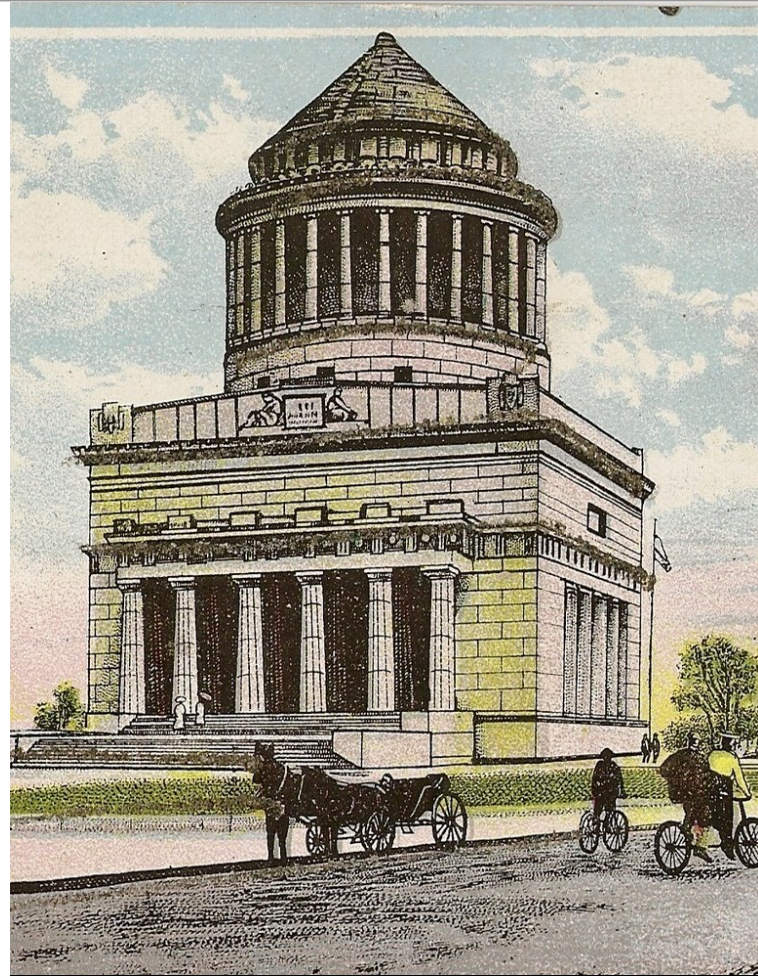
The keynote address will be given by **Dr. Edwina Campbell**, a former U.S. Foreign Service officer, and professor of foreign policy, grand strategy, and national security studies. Her latest book, *Citizen of a Wider Commonwealth: Ulysses S. Grant's Postpresidential Diplomacy*, was published in 2016. A book-signing will follow the ceremony in the visitor center.

Remarks will also be given by **Brigadier General Diana M. Holland**, 76th Commandant of Cadets, U.S. Military Academy, West Point on behalf of the President of the United States. In addition, an United States Military Academy Corps of Cadets and West Point Honor Guard will conduct a wreath laying ceremony and rifle salute.

\*A musical performance by the **Antebellum Marine Band** will precede the ceremony, beginning at 10:30 am.

The ceremony is open to the public, and some seating is provided on a first-come first-served basis. In the event of inclement weather, the ceremony will be moved inside the mausoleum.
