*WHEREAS, on August 1, 2022, Colorado will celebrate 146 years of statehood; and*

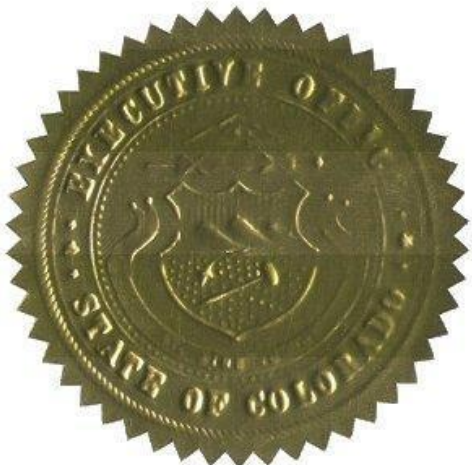
*WHEREAS, the Centennial State of Colorado honors President Ulysses S. Grant on his 200th birthday;*
